Attached is the correct formation for manuscript letters. Please check to see if your son holds his pencil correctly. He should also be writing his letters starting at the top for upper-case (capital letters) and in the middle or at the top for lower-case letters. It is easier to correct before it becomes a habit.

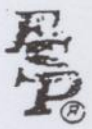
Writing Lower-Case Letters
