The 25 Years Fund Building Campaign was established in 2009 by the Board of Trustees in celebration of Stuart Hall's 25th year of forming *Leaders for Life*. This fund seeks to address capital needs not covered in the school's regular operating budget. *The 25 Years Fund* is a naming rights initiative, and we wish to recognize our supporters in a perpetual way, as well as to continue to increase the monetary foundation upon which our beloved school will prosper. Since 2009, more than forty campus areas have been dedicated.

Gifts to the fund are welcome in all sizes, and all gifts will be acknowledged on *The 25 Years Fund* donor sign at the entrance to the Middle School Building. Individual campus namings begin at \$2,500 and can be paid in annual increments up to five years. Previous gifts to the Legacy of Leadership Campaign (2002-2007) can be combined with pledges to *The 25 Years Fund* to open a wider range of naming opportunities.

Property Improvements

Each summer, the Facilities Committee of the Board of Trustees works closely with the Headmaster and the Director of Facilities to determine the most pressing needs on our school's property. The greatest importance is placed on property improvements that will ensure the safety of the members of our school community and enhance the educational experience of our boys. *The 25 Years Fund* has directly supported a new Faculty Nursery, waterproofing our buildings, renovations, an enhanced security system and equipment replacement.

Technology Investments and Upgrades

In order to form leaders for today's fast-paced world, the faculty and administration of Stuart Hall recognize the importance of incorporating technology into all facets of education. All of our classrooms are equipped with SMARTBoards, and many with SMARTTables, document cameras, data projectors, multiple computer stations, digital cameras and wireless Internet. There are also two sets of Senteo Student Response Systems and a bank of flip cameras for school-wide use.

Title II funding enabled Stuart Hall to invest in these important educational tools initially; our needs continue to grow as our school population increases and trends in technology change. Technology enables a ***stimulating and interactive*** learning environment which helps boys internalize information more effectively. In preparation for each new school year, our Director of Technology assesses our current equipment acquisition and upgrade needs.

Funds for Future Property Ownership

Stuart Hall wishes to claim full ownership of the Stuart Hall campus, including those buildings currently under lease agreement, and to be poised and ready for real estate opportunities as they arise. Understanding that real estate prospects can arise with little notice and limited time to react, the Board has set aside capital funds, including those raised by *The 25 Years Fund Campaign*, to be best prepared for these opportunities.

Campus Expansion: Remaining Debt

In 2002, Stuart Hall embarked on a campus expansion plan to significantly increase enrollment and improve the school experience for our boys both academically and socially. The plan included the construction of the Early Childhood Center, the Multi-Purpose Building and Gymnasium, and improvements to the school's playgrounds and leased properties. As a result, the school grew from 218 students in 2002 to 333 in 2011, with the lowest attrition rate in the school's history.

To fund this expansion, the *Building a Legacy of Leadership Capital Campaign* (2002-2007) raised \$2 million. The expansion was also funded by two bonds from the Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (LPFA), with payments amortized over sixteen years. To help cover the interest expense on these bonds, the Board instituted a building fee of \$1,000 per student at the onset of the expansion. *The 25 Years Fund* helps to reduce the building debt sooner in order to direct future resources to our other capital needs and future programs.

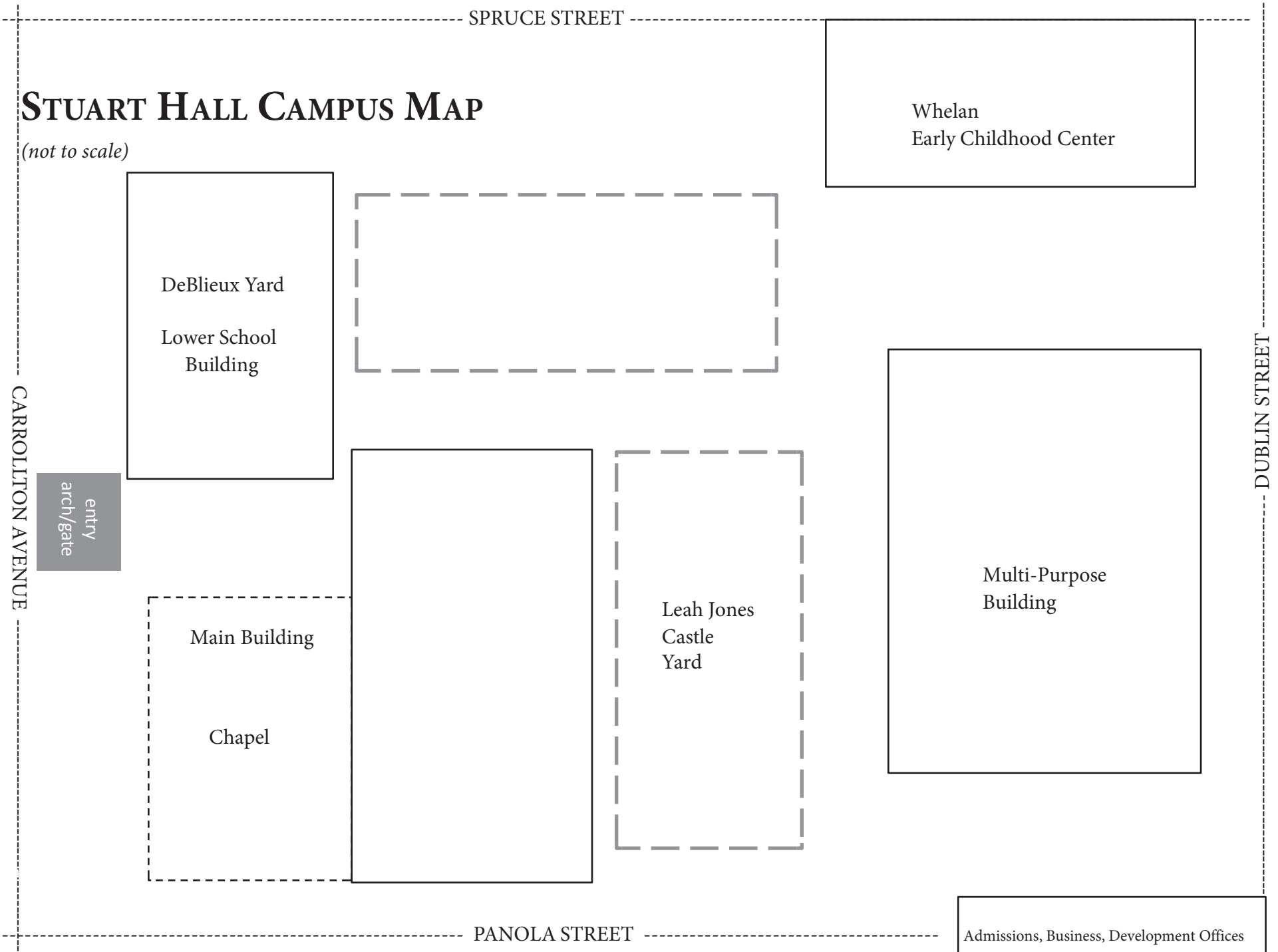

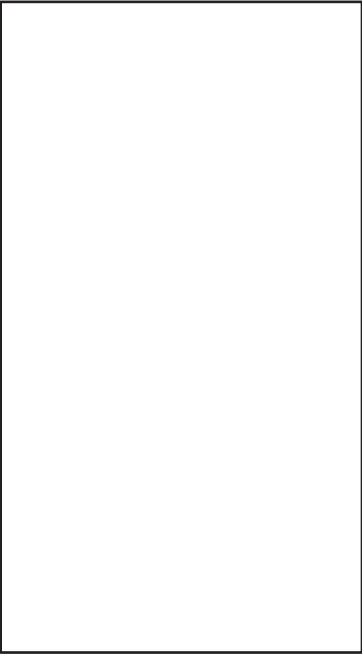

The 25 Years Fund was established last year by the Board of Trustees in celebration of Stuart Hall's 25th year of forming leaders for life. This fund seeks to address our capital needs--those not covered in our regular operating budget--to include:

- **Campus Enhancements**
- **Technology Upgrades**
- **Debt Reduction on Campus Expansion**
- **Future Property Acquisition**

Gifts to the fund can be restricted to any of the above four areas, or can be unrestricted, and thus applied to the school's most immediate need at the time of the gift.


